

Guardian Functional Exercises

Guardian provides the next level of service from the table-top exercise. This exercise is called a functional exercise, which focuses on one or several functions within the disaster management process. This allows you to provide real-world and practical evolutions to enhance what you have learned from the table-top exercises. For example, Guardian can run through evolutions of relocation of victims, helicopter landing zone operations, and family reunification center activations. This means we would work directly with your organization or community to choose specific function(s) to test and conduct evolutions of these functions. This takes less time to plan and conduct than a full-scale exercise. It also allows you to focus on the details of these specific functions, which further enhances the specific protocols of crisis management operations.

Note: The examples above are the current list of functional exercises we offer. However, we can work with your team to customize functional exercises and create new functional exercises based on your specific needs in your organization or community.
